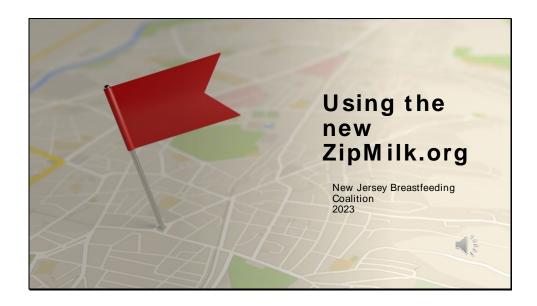
# Using the new ZipMilk.org

#### Slide 1



Welcome to this tutorial on using the new ZipMilk.org website. My name is Danielle Tropea, and I'm one of the New Jersey Zip Milk Administrators at the New Jersey Breastfeeding Coalition.

ZipMilk.org is a database of lactation providers and community support, searchable by zip code. It was created and is run by the Massachusetts Breastfeeding Coalition.

The NJ Breastfeeding Coalition pays an annual fee to be part of it.

Two of our neighboring states, Pennsylvania and Connecticut, also participate.

Search results now include our neighboring states, Pennsylvania and Connecticut.

For example, if you are based in Camden, Philadelphia-based families entering their zip code can also see you and vice versa.



The new ZipMilk.org looks very different. There's a completely new layout.

There are more steps to creating your listing.

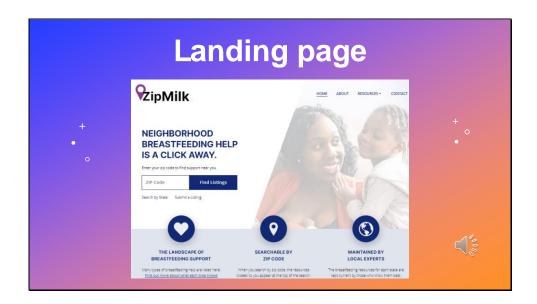
You don't have to confirm your listing like you did with the old version.

You will get an email confirming it's been received and one when it's published.

To edit it save the published listing email.

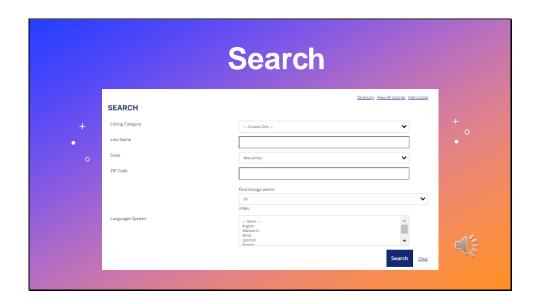
The new listing template allows you to include more information. At this point though users can't search by them.

Unlike the old version, we aren't notified when new listings are added so there can be a delay in getting your listing published. To expedite publication of your listing, please email us at nj@zipmilk.org with your business name.



The landing page is where parents can search for providers based on zip code and by the state.

It's also the same page where you can submit your own listing.



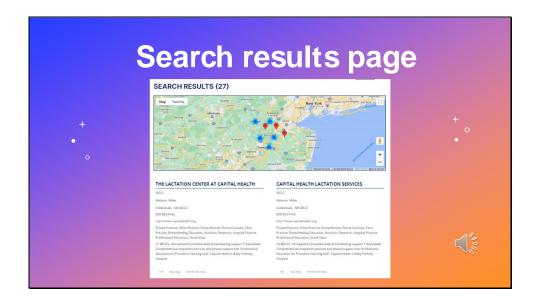
First let's look at the search page.

#### Users can search based:

on the type of provider – IBCLC, WIC, community groups, etc. Only one at a time OR all of them Their state

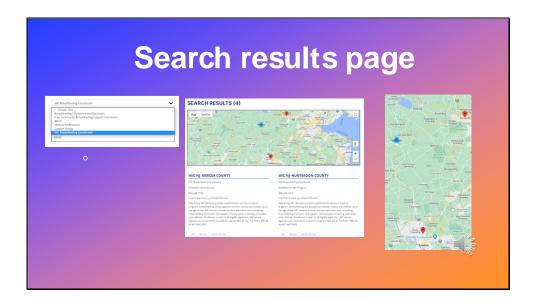
### Zip code

Proximity – the default is set as 20 miles but it can be changed to to 1, 5, 10, 30, and 50 And languages spoken. Because of this, if you speak a language other than English, when you create your listing, make sure you select it!



I entered the zip code for Pennington, NJ (08534) and did not select a category of provider. It pulled up these 19 listings.

But if I want to narrow my search down to another category of provider like WIC...

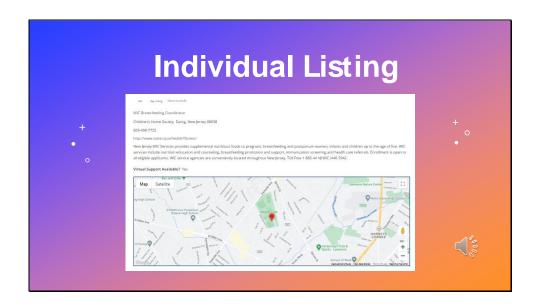


I'm going to scroll back up to the search section and select WIC Breastfeeding Coordinators.

It pulls up the four closest WIC offices.

I can zoom in or out on the map to see where they are located. If you click on the little square within the top right side of the map, you can see it full screen. This is helpful if the user wants to see which is the closest to them.

I can access each listing by either clicking on the name in capital letters OR click the View the full listing link in tiny print at the bottom of the listing.

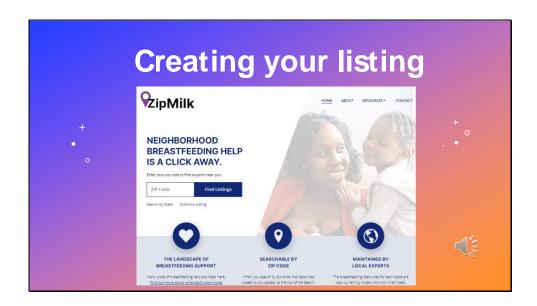


#### Here you can see:

The category
Address
Phone number
Website
Description
That they offer virtual support
as well as a map

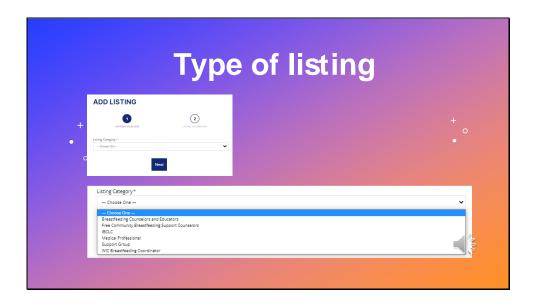
You can zoom in or out on this map too.

This listing doesn't use all of the possible fields. We'll check that out in a minute.



We're going to create your listing, now so we'll go back to the landing page.

We'll click Submit a Listing, directly under find Listings.

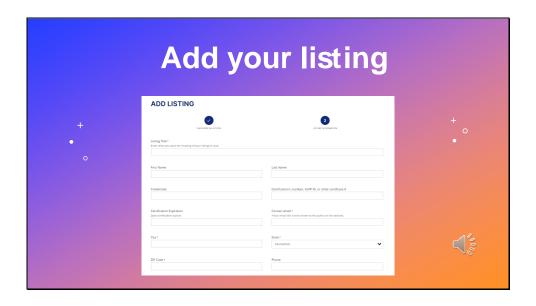


Click Listing Category. Your options are: Listing categories

- Breastfeeding Counselors and Educators
- Free Community Breastfeeding Support Counselors
- IBCLC
- Medical Professional
- Support Group
- WIC Breastfeeding Coordinator

#### Some things to know:

- If you selected the wrong category or you need to change your category- like from Lactation Counselor to IBCLC CONGRATS by the way! You can do it later
- If you would like to be listed under more than one category, you need to create separate listings



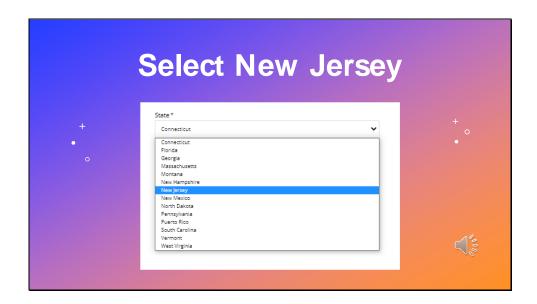
#### Required fields:

- Listing Title this would be your business name or your name
- Contact email address make sure you enter this correctly or you won't be able to edit your listing in the future
- City
- State
- Zip Code

However, you should include as much information as you can.

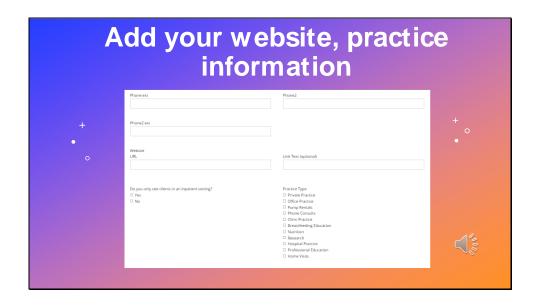
Your Certification number and expiration date fields won't be displayed on your list nor will your contact email with the asterisk.

Scroll down to see more fields...

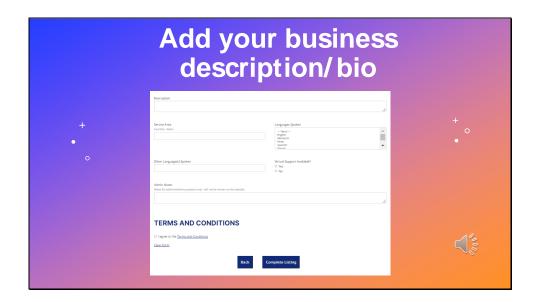


Second to making sure you've entered your correct email is selecting the correct state.

If you don't select NJ, we won't be able to see it to approve it.



I've scrolled down to see more fields.



We can now see the Description box. This is where you can enter your bio, business information, etc. Any websites you list here will not be linked.

You can expand the description entry box by clicking and dragging on the diagonal lines in the bottom right corner.

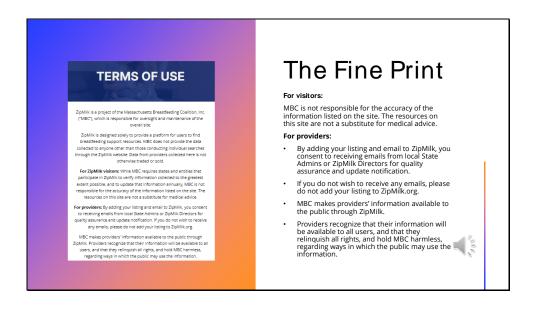
Unlike the old ZipMilk, you can separate lines in the description field. Just hit enter.

Under languages, make sure you select English as well as any others you speak. If you do not select English and someone searches English, you won't show up!

Although the service area is not searchable, if you do home visit will be helpful for families viewing your listing.

I recommend you read the Terms and Conditions before clicking "I agree to the Terms and Conditions"

Now click Complete Listing



Since you probably didn't read the Terms & Conditions, here is what you're agreeing to as a provider.

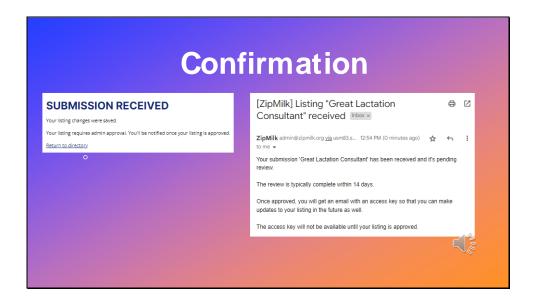
## For providers:

By adding your listing and email to ZipMilk, you consent to receiving emails from local State Admins or ZipMilk Directors for quality assurance and update notification.

If you do not wish to receive any emails, please do not add your listing to ZipMilk.org.

MBC makes providers' information available to the public through ZipMilk.

Providers recognize that their information will be available to all users, and that they relinquish all rights, and hold MBC harmless, regarding ways in which the public may use the information.



After you clicked Complete Listing, you'll see this confirmation.

You will receive an email with the subject line: [ZipMilk] Listing "your listing title" received. If you don't see this in your email, please check your Spam folder.

You will need to wait until the listing is approved.

Please keep in mind that NJBC is not notified by ZipMilk when listings are submitted or edited.

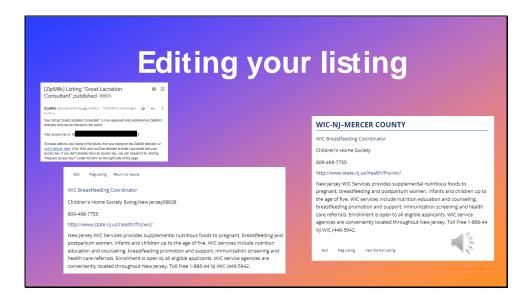
We check the site once a week to approve and publish listings. For speedier approval, please email us at nj@zipmilk.org with subject line Zipmilk.



Congrats! You'll receive an email letting you know that your listing has been published.

This email contains your unique access key - save it!

If you would like to edit your listing and can't find the original email or where you saved it, you can request it.

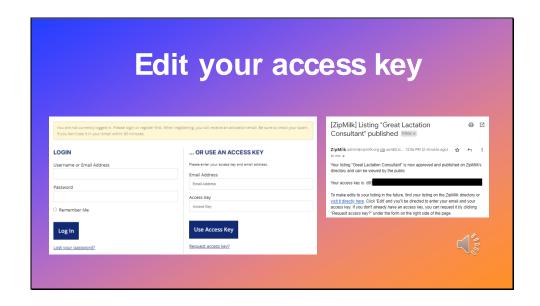


There are a few ways to get to your listing to edit it.

- Find the email that confirmed your listing. Click "visit it directly here"
- Search for your listing using the search function. Enter your last name to save time.
- On the search results page, locate your listing and click the Edit link at the bottom of the listing.
- If you've bookmarked your page, go there click Edit above the category name.

There's a link at the bottom of the page that says Admin. That's for the backend administrator.

Uh oh. Are you trying to edit your listing but can't find your access key?



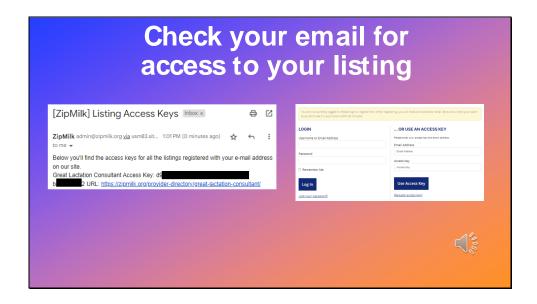
This part is a little confusing.

You won't be able to log in. However, you will be able to log in using an access key. Enter the email address you used to create your listing.

Then enter your access key. Where is it? Go back to that confirmation email and copy the long code that follows the text "your access key is"

Now paste it in the Access Key field and click Use Access Key.

Can't find the email with the access key? Click the Request access key? link. Then enter your email address and click Continue.

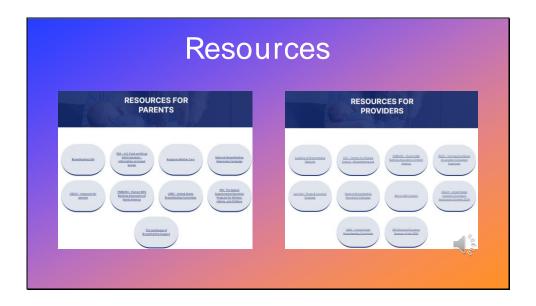


check your email for an email with the subject line "[ZipMilk] Listing Access Keys." This will give you the access key and direct link to your listing.

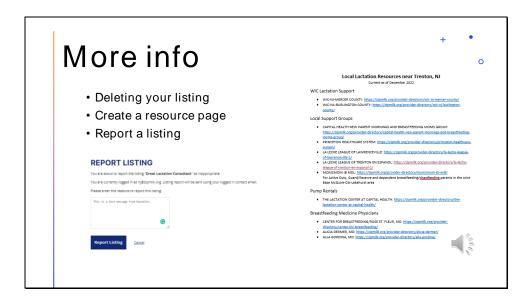
Copy your access key – keeping in mind it will overflow onto the next line.

Go back to the Use an access key section and enter your info.

It will take you back to the Edit Listing page which looks exactly the same as the Add Listing pages.



Finally, ZipMilk has some basic links for Parents and Providers.



If you would like to delete your listing, this is only something we can do. If you want to do it please email us at nj@zipmilk.org with the exact link to your page.

A unique URL will be assigned to each listing. You might want to utilize it by creating a list of other providers you recommend. For example, if you are not available, you might want to share the listings of your colleagues who might be. You could also use it as a listing of local resources such as hospital lactation support, WIC offices, free community breastfeeding support, tongue tie release providers, etc.

Hopefully, you won't need to do this but if you see a listing that is inappropriate, you can report it. I can't think of any reasons off the top of my head for why you'd report a listing. Maybe if you know someone is misrepresenting themselves. Such as saying they're an IBCLC when you know they're not.
